1. Right to vote at Hunt meetings and receive all Hunt literature. No hunting rights.
2. When a horse is entered into the "Members' Race" then the jockey must be either a Farmer, Subscriber or Member of the OSB & WKH.

Children. Children are welcome at all meets but, apart from designated childrens' meets, must be accompanied by a responsible riding adult who must remain with them throughout the day. Pony Club children wishing to hunt for the first time should contact their Pony Club DC, Mrs. Janet Stakemire (01732 862005) Mrs. Jane Scott (01474 872238) or the Hunt Secretary prior to the meet. Non Pony Club children must contact the Hunt Secretary.

Subscribers Guests - Full Hunter subscribers may bring a guest out on 2 occasions. Guest tickets at £20 each must be purchased before 1st November, and may be used by the subscriber in lieu of field money at the end of the season if not used for guests. Subscribers companions without a valid guest ticket will always be required to pay a Visitors Cap. No one will be allowed to hunt as a guest on more than two occasions in total. Please speak to the Hunt Secretary before bringing out a guest.

Countryside Alliance Membership - Everyone who hunts with the Old Surrey Burstow & West Kent Hunt is required to belong to the Countryside Alliance.

Insurance - Hunting can be a hazardous sport and anyone who hunts should have adequate public liability and personal accident insurance cover. Please note that the Countryside Alliance insurance only covers your actual hunting activity and not, for example, hacking to or from the meet.

Neighbouring Hunts - We have reciprocal hunting arrangements with a number of neighbouring hunts but as these arrangements vary please contact the Hunt Secretary for details.

Mobile Telephone Numbers - Subscribers can now be notified by SMS text messaging of any last minute changes or cancellations to meets. If you are not yet registered please add £5 to your subscription payment and include your mobile telephone number.
